The Circuit 02

The circuit starts outside Bettys Café Tea Rooms on The Grove, right in Ilkley's town centre. The bandstand area opposite will host Ilkley Brewery's pop-up bar together with Lishman's barbeque and La Stazione's prosecco tuk-tuk. After a 90° righthand turn there is a 200m long climb up the Riddings Road ramp. After another righthander, there is a long stretch of false flat along Albany Walk onto Parish Ghyll Drive.

By this point, the gradient has eased although it is likely to be this stretch where strong riders will really be able to press home an advantage. The top of the circuit is reached just before the end of Parish Ghyll Drive, where the course drops sharply down Wilton Road. A very fast corner will sweep the riders onto Grove Road for an extremely rapid return to the bars, restaurants and shops along the finish straight on The Grove.

The tough circuit climbs 32 m on each 1.5 km lap.

From Ilkley to the Iseran



I still vividly remember my first ride with Ilkley Cycling Club, back in January 2016. The 'A' ride went for huge jaunt out to Leighton and Lofthouse. I had been riding for about a month then, and this 6 hour ride was an enormity, but the kindness of everyone

there got me round in one piece. After that incredibly formative day out, I'd go out pretty much every week with the club; I was a regular on the Thursday evening training rides and the Sunday 'A' rides. I was taught everything I needed to know about how to do group rides: pointing out holes, riding in tight formation and so on. In addition, my odd foray with the Saturday morning 'chain-gang' not only made me stronger, but helped me learn how to ride 'through-and-off' properly – a skill that is painstakingly lacking in some of the breakaways I've experienced in France!

It was through ICC that I first started racing, too. Back in the days when the North Yorkshire Evening Road Race League still ran, Mike Firth would very kindly give me a lift on a Wednesday evening and I would get my first tastes of road racing. It wasn't very glamorous being spat-out in a little 3-4 road race, but we all have to start somewhere! Over the year, with the help of everyone from the club, and the extended Wharfedale cycling community, I was able to truly find my feet racing.





I still fondly remember the trip to do the Scottish Tour of the Lammermuirs that Mike put on for us to really finish off the season with style!

I now race abroad in France, this year with the Division One team, GSC Blagnac. In my two and a half seasons racing abroad I've done 115 mile point to point road races, raced up (and down!) the Col d'Aubisque, and even won my own polka dot jersey! It's a very different kettle of fish to a dark and snowy 3-4 race up round Pennypot, but I owe a lot to the foundation given to me by the community at Ilkley Cycling Club, and without it I certainly would not be where I am.

The Ilkley Town Centre Races are a highlight of the calendar, for myself, the club, and the town. Back in 2017 I remember having one of the toughest races of my life in the men's support race. My heart was in my mouth the whole race but I was delighted to manage third and a trip to the podium, with the eventual winner Sam Watson, who now races for the World Tour team Groupama-FDJ. The course is brilliantly designed and always makes for some quality racing, its relentless nature is a true spectacle.






